# Privacy Policy May 2018

When you share your personal data with us, we treat it with care and take our responsibility to protect it seriously. We aim to be clear when we collect your data and not do anything you wouldn't reasonably expect.

We abide by the UK Data Protection Act 1998 and GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) May 2018 and will not pass your details to a third party without your permission.

DriverMetrics Ltd, is registered with the Information Commissioners Office and adhere to the following principles:

- Personal data shall be processed fairly and lawfully.
- Personal data collection is obtained under the 'Legitimate Interests' lawful basis for processing.
- Personal data shall be obtained only for the specified purposes and shall not be further processed in any manner incompatible with that purpose.
- Personal data shall be adequate, relevant and not excessive in relation to the purpose for which it is collected.
- Personal data shall be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date.
- Personal data processed shall not be kept for longer than is necessary for the purpose.

#### <u>Users Rights under GDPR</u>

In order to comply with the new regulations under GDPR, our users are afforded the following rights to their data:

Right of erasure – such requests should be directed to contact@drivermetrics.com from the email address registered on our database (in order to confirm identity). Upon receipt our IT team will go into the database and anonymise their data using a unique erasure code.

**Right to rectification** – users can amend their account details by logging on to their accounts and selecting 'My Details'. If they have any further requests they should email contact@drivermetrics.com

Right of access – users should send a description of the information they want want to see and proof of your identity by post to: DriverMetrics Ltd, Linden House Studio, 199 Ham Street, Richmond, TW10 7Hl. (We do not accept

these requests by email so we can ensure that we only provide personal data to the right person). If you require further information, please contact contact@drivermetrics.com.

**Right to restrict processing** – users should submit requests to contact@drivermetrics.com.

Right to data portability – we offer our users requesting a copy of their personal data in a common, machine readable format of XML, Excel or JSON format. In order to send the data securing we will provide a password protected file and telephone the user with the password.

**Right to object** – this can be achieved either by the deletion.

Right not be subject to automated decision making including profiling – DriverMetrics marketing and communications does not use automated decision making.

#### Cookies

Like most websites, we use 'cookies' to help us make our site, and the way you use it, better. Cookies man that a website will remember you. #### Data Security
